SIDEWALK SNOW & ICE REMOVAL

To help keep our community safe and walkable, all property owners and occupants, both residential and commercial, are responsible for clearing sidewalks next to their property. Snow, ice, sleet, and hail should be removed within 12 hours after precipitation stops and sidewalks should be kept clear as conditions change. Please note that even if a contractor is hired to do the work, the responsibility for compliance remains with the property owner or occupant. Thank you for doing your part to keep sidewalks safe and accessible for everyone.



Penalty: Up to \$300 per day (each day is a separate offense)

DO NOT PUT SNOW IN THE STREET



Snow, ice, or sleet may not be shoveled, plowed, or blown into streets or alleys. Shoveling or plowing snow into streets, roads, or gutters is illegal in many areas and poses serious safety risks. It creates dangerous hazards for drivers, blocks traffic, impedes municipal snow removal efforts, and can cause ice to form. Instead, snow should be placed on private property, such as lawns or gardens. Applies to residents and contractors.

Penalty: Up to \$300 and/or up to 10 days imprisonment (per day)

KEEP FIRE HYDRANTS CLEAR

Do not block or bury fire hydrants. Keep fire hydrants clear by maintaining a 3-foot radius of space around them, free from snow, ice, and debris. In winter, this ensures firefighters can quickly locate and access water during emergencies. Shovel a path from the hydrant to the street, and never park in front of one.

Hydrants must be visible and accessible at all times.

Penalty: Up to \$1,000 and/or up to 90 days imprisonment (per day)
