## SNOW & ICE REMOVAL REQUIREMENTS

(Article III – Adopted March 4, 2019)

To help keep traffic moving safely and reduce hazards caused by snow and ice, the Mayor may declare a Snow or Ice Emergency when conditions require it. Snow emergencies are announced through ReadyBucks and Borough of Penndel Facebook page. Updates will also be provided through the same channels when the Snow Emergency has ended.

Your cooperation helps snow crews clear roads more efficiently and keeps everyone safer during winter weather.

### SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES – NO PARKING

When the Mayor declares a Snow Emergency, **NO PARKING AT ANY TIME** on the following streets and applies for the entire duration of the emergency:

**Bellevue Ave • Centre St • Crescent St • DeHaven Ave  
Durham Rd • Hulmeville Ave • Lincoln Hwy  
Neshaminy St • Woodland Ave**



Vehicles may be ticketed and towed at owner's expense

**Ticket:** \$50 + towing/storage costs

### PARKING DURING A SNOW STORM

(Applies when 2+ inches of snow or any ice falls)

1. No parking on the **odd-numbered side** while it's being plowed
2. Then no parking on the **even-numbered side** until plowing is done

If plowing finishes overnight, vehicles **do not need to move to the even-numbered side until 8:00 a.m.**

**Ticket:** \$25 (vehicles may be towed)

When moving your vehicle, park as far from the corner of the street as possible, at least 25 feet. Vehicles parked too close to the corner get in the way of snow plows or emergency vehicles trying to turn corners.



Snow emergencies are announced through ReadyBucks and Borough of Penndel Facebook page. Following these rules helps emergency services and snow crews keep roads safe.
